Shelter in Place Order that becomes effective tomorrow, March 25<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 11:59 p.m. The entire order is viewable on the City of Crandall website, the City of Crandall Facebook page, as well as the Official Website of Kaufman County.

This Order will be in place until April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at 11:59 p.m. or until it is either rescinded, superseded or amended pursuant to applicable law.

Had the Kaufman County Judge not issued a Shelter in Place order, we the Council had a Shelter in Place order ready to implement. Realizing that any order we the City would have implemented would have been superseded by the County we agreed to wait until the Council met and released their order.
