Mayor Kirbie called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. Ron Lanier gave the invocation followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

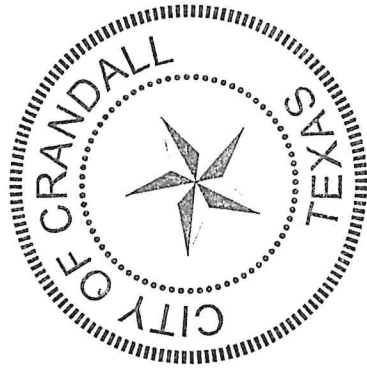
2. Roll Call -



Discuss and consider Resolution No. 041321, A Resolution of the City of Crandall setting a Public Hearing under SEC. 372.009 of the Texas Local Government Code on the advisability of the adjustment to the Boundaries of the Cartwright Ranch Public Improvement District within the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction of the City of Crandall, Texas; authorizing the issuance of notice by the City Secretary of Crandall, Texas regarding the public hearing; and providing an effective date -

City Manager, Jana Shelton, explained to the Council that this resolution is to remove the TxDot property from the previous resolution and will allow for publication and notification to property owners by the City Secretary.
