SPECIAL MEETING

1. **Open Meeting, Invocation, Pledge of Allegiance-**
Mayor Lindsey called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the invocation, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.
2. **Roll Call-**
Mayor Lindsey conducted roll call. Councilmember Atkins and Councilmember Holden were absent. All other council members were present.
3. **Discuss and consider Ordinance No. 05162023 – An Ordinance of the City of Crandall, Texas, canvassing and certifying the election returns, including the returns of early voting ballots cast in connection with the election held on Saturday May 6, 2023, regarding two (2) councilmembers and one (1) Mayor. Declaring the results; providing for the certification of election results to the Texas Secretary of State; and providing for an immediate effective date-**
Mayor Lindsey read aloud the unofficial results from Kaufman County. David Lindsey with 260 votes, Katy Vaughan with 291 votes, George Martinez with 127 votes, and Caleb Allen with 166 votes.


Councilmember Rogers made a motion to approve. Councilmember Vaughan seconded the motion. The motion was carried out with a unanimous vote of 3-0.


